All participants will receive a USA Made BUCK knife with their registration!

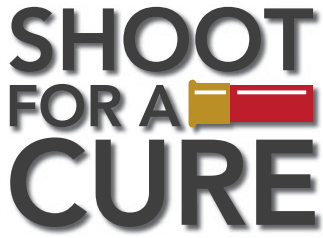

FROM ATLANTA- From Atlanta, take I-85 South to Exit 61. Turn left on Highway 74 through Peachtree City. Turn right on GA 85 South through Senoia, Haralson and Alwatan. Turn right at traffic light on Highway 109. Entrance to Big Red Oak Plantation is 1/2 mile on left.

FROM SAVANNAH- Take I-16 West to I-75 North to Exit 185 (Hwy. 18). Follow west through Barnesville, Zebulon, and Concord to Woodbury. Turn north onto GA 85, travel into Gay. Turn left at traffic light in Gay. Turn east to Spur 109, travel approximately 9 miles. Entrance to Big Red Oak Plantation is 1/2 mile on left.
